**Arenas/Footing:** Grass and sand rings, gently sloping ground, approximately 300' by 150'. Grass Warmup.

**Water:** Water available on grounds.

**Food:** Corner store nearby.

**Jump Rounds:** Each rider will ride three rounds. The first round will include an equitation score for one round in addition to knock down score. All rounds will be timed for appropriate divisions. There will be a "Take Your Own Line" round, and a jump off for Developing and above.

\*Cross Rails, Beginner and Green Horse are Non-Qualifying Arounds

\*Cross Rail, Beginner, Green, and Intro courses are not timed

\*A minimum of one third of obstacles will be set at max height for qualifying rounds

- Entry Fee (\$40 per rider & \$10 per Stable Manger, or \$170 per team)
- Organizer has the right to deny late entries, if accepted a \$25 late fee will be charged. Entries not completed by closing date will be considered late.
- Make your Club's check payable to the Northeast Region USPC. Only club checks accepted.

**Teams:** Teams consist of 3-4 riding members and a stable manager.

Horsemasters and Pony Clubbers cannot be on teams together, Horsemasters will be its own division.
