# **Old Business**

RS Report - Beth Sypher presented

- Plus 1 Membership Challenge update Currently a total of 103 members, currently 3<sup>rd</sup> in the nation for % change in the challenge!
- **Champs update** Only 2 quiz kids and 1 possible BN eventer interested for 2015, all from Penobscot. Beth asked if there was any interest from other clubs but no clubs have any interested members for this year.
- Regional Policy Update Our policies need to be updated. The deadline for update and submission to National Office is August 1<sup>st</sup>.
